2019 Grant Program

The Saskatoon Nature Society aims to strengthen existing programs and encourage new initiatives that connect youth in the Saskatoon area with nature. We will invite applications from existing or new programs and select one or more for financial support. The total funding available is approximately \$2000.00. This amount may go to one applicant or may be divided among several applicants.

Who can apply?

We will accept proposals from educational institutes including primary or secondary schools, community associations, Aboriginal bands, and registered charities in the Saskatoon area. If you would like to discuss submitting a project but feel that you don't meet this criterion, please contact the Saskatoon Nature Society by e-mail at president@saskatoonnaturesociety.sk.ca

What types of projects can be submitted?

The project must target children or youth up to and including 18 years of age. Funds can be used for a new project or an existing ongoing project. Priority will be given to projects with a focus on local natural history. Please note that gardening projects that do not focus on local natural history will not be considered.

How do I apply?

Complete the form below and e-mail (or post) it to the address indicated by December 31, 2018. We will contact you by January 31, 2019 if your submission has been successful or not.

To help make your proposal a success you should know a few things:

Submitting a form is not a guarantee that a project will be funded.

Please submit just one proposal. If you send in more than one we will simply review the one we receive first.
